As part of our commitment to bring art education into the community, the Boca Raton Fine Art Show, November 2 & 3, 2019, invites young artists ages 5-13 or grades K-8 to enter his/her *original and personally handmade* works of art into the Youth Art Competition. All categories of discipline are open, and the entries will be displayed during the entire art show. There is \$250 in Youth Art Awards: one \$100 Best of Youth Art; and three \$50 Youth Art Awards of Excellence. Judging is based on originality, technique and execution. Be imaginative and creative as you begin to learn the rules of being part of a professional art show! Please read the “Rules” below.

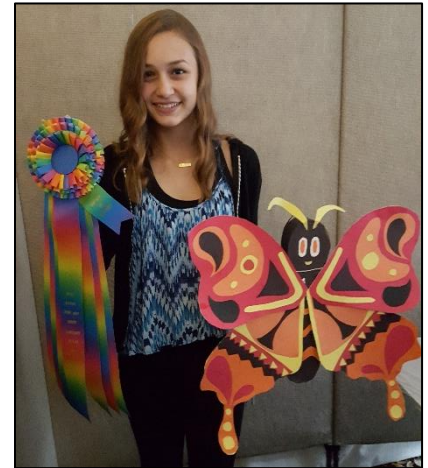

Rules:

- To enter you must be in grades K thru 8 or ages 5-13. Please note your age as of the closing date of the competition, which is on October 1, 2019. You may enter up to two pieces of art work. Entry fee is \$3 per entry. Please make check payable to “Institute for the Arts & Education, Inc.” and include with application to PO Box 1425, Sarasota, FL 34230.
- Copies of application are acceptable.
- Please print legibly when completing this application.
- Please include a photograph of your art work, with size dimensions labeled clearly.
- Please include a signature of your parent, teacher or guardian on this application.
- Your entry must be certified as being original and unaided. Accepted medium of art work includes:
 Painting Clay Glass Printmaking Drawing Metal Mixed-Media
 Jewelry Fiber Wood Photography Sculpture Digital Other
- Framing is optional, however, **paintings, drawings, photography, and other flat art work must be ready to hang with a wire attached approximately 1/3 from the top, whether framed or not.**
- The closing date for entries to be received is no later than October 1, 2019.
- Works of art must be exhibited for the entire event, until 3pm on Sunday. No early removal of art works is permitted.
- There are four Youth Art Competition awards totaling \$250: first prize is \$100; and three secondary prizes are \$50 each. Awards are given at judges’ discretion based on originality, technique and execution. If your entry reaches the final judging stage and is being considered for an award, you may be asked to submit your birth certificate. Winner does not need to be present to win. Awards will be paid at event or immediately following event.
- All winners will be photographed with their art work and posted on the event website, hotworks.org.
- The person signing below acknowledges and authorizes the Boca Raton Fine Art Show to use the Youth Art Competition photographs for promotional purposes for past or future events.
- The Boca Raton Fine Art Show cannot be held responsible for plagiarism in student art work.
- Art work is to be delivered to the event site, on Friday, November 1, between 8am-2pm. Please deliver art work to the check-in booth located at Mizner Park Amphitheater. Include your name and telephone number, plus title of entry, if any, on the back of your art work.
- Winners will be announced and the awards distributed on Sunday, November 3, at 3pm. Winners need not be present to win. Art work may be picked up on Sunday any time after 3pm. Art work not picked up becomes the property of the Boca Raton Fine Art Show. We cannot store art work and are not responsible for any art work not picked up during the designated pick up time.
- The Boca Raton Fine Art Show; Hot Works, LLC; and Institute for the Arts & Education, Inc. will use best efforts to take utmost care of art work; however, neither can be made responsible for any damage to work.
- The rules of the competition may not be changed or modified and will be strictly applied.
- The student and parents assume all responsibility for insurance coverage of all art work entered in the Boca Raton Fine Art Show.
- By parent, legal guardian or art teacher signing this agreement, you accept the rules listed in this application, as well as additional rules of the event.
