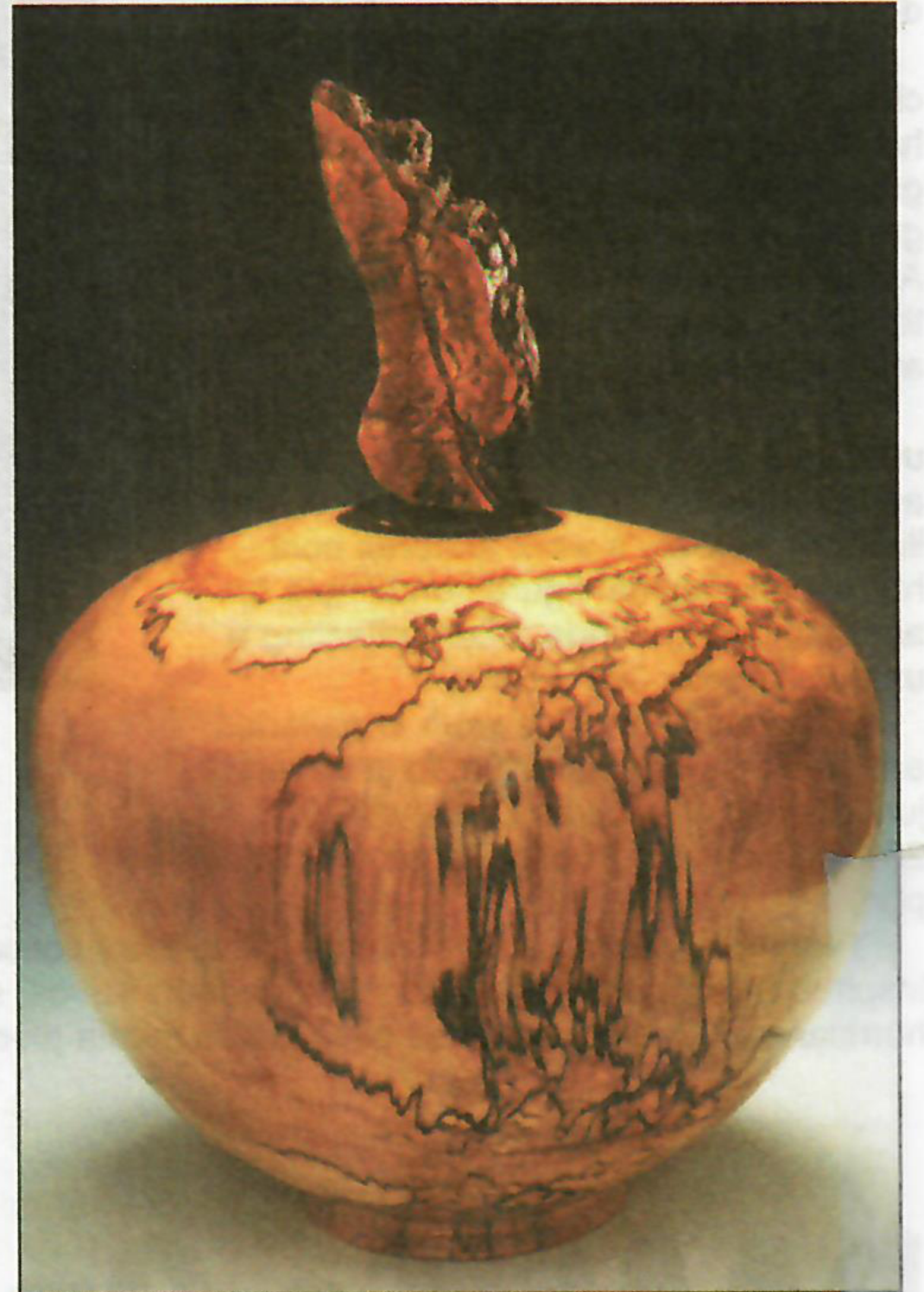
Hot Works, LLC has announced the debut of a new art show in Naples in December.

The Naples Fine Art Show will take place Dec. 15 and 16 at the Galleria Shoppes at Vanderbilt in Naples, announced Hot Works executive producer Patty Narozny. The new show will run from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. both days at the 2343 Vanderbilt Beach Road location.

Narozny tends to every detail of the show to ensure the art is authentic, personally handmade by the artist who is in the show. The focus is quality, not quantity. There is something for everyone, in all price ranges, she says.

The show features up to 175 juried, professional artists in all discipline whose art is for sale to the public. Juried by art professionals, the criteria is based on originality, technique, execution, and overall booth presentation. Local, national and international acclaimed artists are invited to display original, one-of-a-kind hand-made creations.

As part of their commitment to include art education into the Southwest Florida community, a youth art competition for grades K-8 or ages 5 - 13 is integrated into the art shows. Sponsored by Institute for the Arts & Education, all young artists are invited to enter his/her original and personally hand-made art which is publicly displayed the duration of the art show. \$250 in Youth Art awards – one \$100 "Best of Youth Art" and three \$50 "Youth Art Awards of Excellence" - as budding artists are exposed to the rules and entrepreneurship opportunity of
