Call for Youth Art entries! As part of our commitment to bring art education into the community, **Hot Works' Asheville Fine Art Show, October 26 & 27, 2019** in downtown Asheville's Pack Square Park integrates a **Youth Art Competition** within a 10x20 area in the professional juried fine art and fine craft show. This program invites all young artists ages 5-13 or grades K-8 to enter his/her *original and personally handmade* works of art that will be publicly displayed during the entire art show within the "**Youth Art Competition**" section. All categories of discipline are accepted (see below). There is \$250 in Youth Art Awards: one \$100 *Best of Youth Art*, and three \$50 *Youth Art Awards of Excellence*. Judging is based on originality – the "wow" factor and execution/technique. Be imaginative and creative as you begin to learn the rules of being part of a professional art fair! Rules:

- To enter, you must be in grades Kindergarten through 8, or ages 5 through 13. Please note your age as of the closing date of the competition, which is on October 10, 2019. You may enter up to two pieces of art work. Entry fee is \$3 per entry. Please make check payable to "Institute for the Arts & Education, Inc." and include with application to: PO Box 1425, Sarasota, FL 34230.
- Please print legibly when completing this application. (We accept copies of this application.)
- Please mail all together: the application, the \$3 fee per entry (per application), and a photograph of your art work, with size dimensions clearly labeled.
- Your entry must be certified as original and unaided. Accepted discipline of art work includes:
 Painting Clay Glass Printmaking Drawing Metal Mixed-Media
 Jewelry Fiber Wood Photography Sculpture Digital Other
- Framing is optional; however, paintings, drawings, photography, and other flat art work must be ready to hang with a wire attached approximately 1/3 from the top, whether framed or not.**
- Works of art must be exhibited for the entire event, until 3pm on Sunday, October 27. No early removal of art work is allowed under any circumstances.
- The closing date for entries is October 10, 2019. Please postmark your entry by this date.
- There are four Youth Art Competition awards totaling \$250: first prize is \$100; and three secondary prizes are \$50 each. Awards are given at judges' discretion and are based on originality and technique/execution. If your entry reaches the final judging stage and is being considered for an award, you may be asked to submit your birth certificate. You do not need to be present to win. Awards will be paid directly at the event, or by November 15, 2018.
- All winners will be photographed with his/her art work which will be posted on the event website, www.HotWorks.org.
- The person signing below acknowledges and authorizes the Asheville Fine Art Show; Hot Works, LLC; Institute for the Arts & Education, Inc.; our sponsors or licensees to use the Youth Art images for promotional purposes for past or future events.

- Please deliver art work to the Info/Check-In/Youth Art booth in Pack Square Park, 80 Court Plaza, downtown Asheville on Friday, October 25, between 8am-1pm, where the art show will be moving in that day until 7pm. Please include your name and telephone number, plus title of entry, if any, on the back of your art work.
- On Sunday, October 27 at 3pm, winners will be announced and the awards distributed. Winners need not be present to win, however, we would appreciate it if you could be there. Art work may be picked up on Sunday any time after 3pm until 5pm, when the show closes.
- Art work not picked up becomes the property of the Asheville Fine Art Show. We cannot store art work and are not responsible for any art work not picked up during the designated pick up time.
- The Institute for the Arts & Education, Inc., the Asheville Fine Art Show; and Hot Works, LLC will use best efforts to take utmost care of art work; however neither can be made responsible for any damage to work.
- The rules of the Competition may not be changed or modified and will be strictly applied.
- The student and parents assume all responsibility for insurance coverage of all art work entered in the Asheville Fine Art Show.
- Parent, legal guardian or art teacher: by signing this agreement, you accept the rules listed in this application, as well as additional rules of the event.
