Call for Youth Artists! As part of our commitment to bring art education into the community, Hot Works' Miami Fine Art Show™ being held at Haulover Park/Bill Bird Marina on February 29 & March 1, 2020 integrates a Budding Artist Competition. Sponsored by **Institute for the Arts & Education**, the associated 501c3 non-profit organization that fosters art education among youth, students in grades 6-12 or ages 9-19 are encouraged to enter his/her original and personally handmade art. All categories of discipline are open; all entries will be publicly displayed during the art show. Young artists have the opportunity to win one of four awards: one \$100 "Best of Youth Art"; and three \$50 "Youth Art Awards of Excellence". Each winner also receives a beautiful two-foot long ribbon. Be imaginative and creative as you begin to learn the rules of being part of a professional art show. Please read the "Rules" below.

Rules:

- To enter, you must be in grades 6 through 12, or ages 9 through 19 – note your age is as of the closing date of the competition, which is February 1, 2020. You may enter up to two pieces of artwork. Entry fee is \$3 per entry. Please make check payable to "Institute for the Arts & Education, Inc." and include with application to PO Box 1425, Sarasota, FL 34230. Please mail **all together**: the application, the \$3 fee per entry, and a photograph of your artwork, with size dimensions clearly labeled.
- Please print legibly when completing this application. Copies of this application are accepted.
- Your entry must be certified as original and unaided. Accepted discipline of artwork includes:

- Framing is optional; however, paintings, drawings, photography, and other flat artwork must be ready to hang with a wire attached approximately 1/3 from the top, whether framed or not.**
- Works of art must be exhibited for the entire event, until 3pm on Sunday, March 1. Early removal of artwork is not permitted.
- There are four Budding Artist Competition Awards totaling \$250: \$100 best of youth art; and three \$50 youth art awards of excellence. Awards are given at judges' discretion. If your entry reaches the final judging stage and is being considered for an award, you may be asked to submit your birth certificate. You do not need to be present to win. Awards will be paid directly at the event or mailed by March 15, 2020.
- All winners will be photographed with their artwork which will be posted on the event website,
www.HotWorks.org.

- Artwork is to be delivered to the event site at Haulover Park, on Friday, February 28, between 8am-2pm. Please take it to the check-in area. Include your name and telephone number, plus title of entry, if any, on the back of your artwork.
- When your artwork is delivered, you will receive instructions to return to the show on Sunday for the awards presentation.
- Winners will be announced, and the awards distributed on Sunday, March 1, 2020 at 3pm. Winners need not be present to win however, we would appreciate it if you could be there. Artwork may be picked up on Sunday any time after 3pm until 5pm, when the show closes.
- Artwork not picked up becomes the property of the Miami Fine Art Show. We cannot store artwork and are not responsible for any artwork not picked up during the designated pick up time.
- The rules of the Competition may not be changed or modified and will be strictly applied.
- The Institute for the Arts & Education, Inc.; the Miami Fine Art Show; and Hot Works, LLC will use best efforts to take utmost care of artwork. However, neither can be made responsible for any damage to work.
- The student and parents assume all responsibility for insurance coverage of all artwork entered in the Miami Fine Art Show.
- Miami-Dade County School District or any of its associated schools are neither endorsing nor sponsoring this event, product or service nor endorsing the views of the sponsoring organizations.**
